## **Details of what to include in your Virgin Money Giving page of the Cornerstone Project and what you are raising funds for.**

10,000+ girls/ladies are working in the Turbhe red light district area in India, many of whom have been trafficked there and are 'owned' by madams who may have 6-10 girls working for them. It takes 5-6 years to earn your way out of this form of modern-day slavery. Many of the girls working in this extensive brothel area are younger than 16, and many have their own children at a young age. Their daughters are vulnerable from the age of 12 years onwards. Many are HIV positive and are living with AIDS.

One of Blythswood Care's partners, Cornerstone Project has worked in the brothel for a number of years and counsels the working ladies as well as their madams and teaches their children. They offer health checks for them. They also plan to do vocational training for the ladies to equip them for alternative work when they earn their way out of the situation they find themselves in.

Cornerstone Project which is funded by Blythswood Care is wanting to build a first-floor extension to further develop this educational work.
