BLYTHSWOOD CARE

Blythswood Care provides practical help for those in need, regardless of their political or religious beliefs or ethnic origins. We help transform lives, serving marginalised and vulnerable people at home and overseas through Education, Community and Gospel.

The Foodbanks exist to meet an identified need in Scotland – to help people who are in financial crisis with a three-day supply of nutritious non-perishable food. Their aim is to meet the person requiring Foodbank's help at their point of need and to offer food and a listening ear in a warm, non-judgemental environment.

PURPOSE of ROLE

- Welcoming people who are referred to Foodbank in a relaxed, friendly way; serving tea/coffee and offering a listening ear, signposting to local services appropriate to current needs.
- Preparing food parcels

MAIN TASKS

- A friendly and warm welcome given to everyone referred to Foodbank
- The ability to get alongside people and signpost to relevant services available to them in the community

PERSON SPECIFICATION

- Good personal hygiene necessary
- Good listening skills essential
- Some manual handling required
- Ability to work both independently and as part of a team
- This role would suit someone who has either 4 hours a week or 2 days
- This role does require a regular time commitment
